Requirement	Deadline*

First Colloquium	Second or third year, but no later than April 30, third year
Declare Intended Graduation Date	Between 6 and 12 months before intended graduation
Second Colloquium	Between 6 and 12 months before graduation
Dissertation Submission (or Extension Request)	January 15, each applicable year, starting in the fourth year
Successful Dissertation Defense	See “S.J.D. Graduation Timelines” below
Final Graduation Deadline	May, seventh year
*NOTE: Candidates planning to graduate within four years will need to complete their oral exams and submit their approved prospectus well in advance of the respective deadlines.

<b>Departmental Affiliation &amp; Thesis Committee</b> To facilitate systematic approach to research with guidance	Student attached to the Department. Advisor and two committee members needed. [Year 1]	Need to constitute committee before completing coursework.
<b>Coursework</b> For acquiring fundamental and essential knowledge in several domains	10-12 approved courses. (4-6) core courses and rest approved electives. Typically takes 2 years. [Year 1 & 2]	1. Electives can be from other faculties / departments. 2. Minimum 3 and Maximum 4 courses per semester
<b>Summer Paper</b>	To help the PhD students kick-start their research early, a summer paper requirement will be introduced into the programme. All first year students (starting from the AY06/07 cohort) will be required to submit a summer paper at the end of their study in Year 1.	Student will also be required to present the summer paper to the department.
<b>Qualifying Examination</b> To ensure that the student is ready to embark on independent research	Following coursework completion. Pass departmental requirements of written and/or oral examination [Year 2]	Prerequisite to proceed to candidacy and proposal stage.
<b>Thesis Proposal</b> To help the candidate refine the research ideas	Written proposal and oral examination. Typically during the 3rd year of the programme [Year 3]	Pre-requisite for finishing dissertation
<b>Teaching Development</b>	Students may be required to assume teaching duties as part of their training after proposal defence. [Year 3 to Year 4]	Departments can choose to appoint.
<b>Doctoral Dissertation</b>	An original piece of research that makes a significant theoretical contribution to a body of knowledge. Written dissertation evaluated by internal and external examiners, followed by oral defence before the committee. The final step in obtaining the PhD degree. [Year 4]	Time frame from proposal to dissertation defence varies between on
